Financial help provided to 'Vishakha'

⊃ Jodhpur: Basically a native of Jodhpur namely Vishakha had turned distressed due to her disease. Everything seemed finish for her, but it was 'sewa Parmo Dharm Trust' that came to her rescue and provided her with a financial help of rupees three lakhs. Vishkha is now happy and invocates for the trust. According to the founder of 'Sewa Parmo Dharm Trust', Mr. Prashant Agarwal this emotional story is related with a native of Jodhpur namely Vishakha Vyas. Vishakha was in grip of a kidney related disease since 2010. One day, she suddenly experienced pain in her abdomen. At this, her father got her medically examined at a nearby hospital where the doctor detected that she had a kidney related problem and advised for kidney transplantation, but her kidney failed to get matched to that of her other family members as her father's blood group is O+ whereas her mother's blood group is A+. So, the doctor advised her father to go for ABO. It is a process under which any person may donate his/her kidney to her. In that case, her entire blood needed to be changed.

It caused further problems as the monthly income of the family was merely rupees 15,000/ and the same had to be utilized in meeting the expenses for three members in the family. The financial condition of Vikas was poor so he wasn't able to pursue with her daughter's treatment on his own. Vikas is working in a private sector and hasn't attended his duties for last six months. He anyhow managed to got his daughter medically examined by collecting funds from some of his relatives and neighborers, but wasn't able to get her daughter's corrective surgery conducted. At such a crucial juncture, he came to know about various 'free of cost' service activities of 'Sewa Parmo Dharm Trust'. He came to Udaipur and met Mr. Prashant Agarwal and briefed him about his sufferings.Information with regard to his family then got collected on behalf of the trust and a financial help of rupees three lakhs was provided to her on behalf of the trust. In this way, the corrective surgery of Vishakha turned possible at Apollo Hospital in New Delhi. Mr. Vikas described this act as a humanitarian act of Seva Parmo Dharm Trust, Vishakha is now physically fit & fine.



In her speech, Mrs. Kamla Devi Agarwal narrated about the accident that occurred in Pandwar which inspired Mr. 'Manav' to dedicate his life in the welfare of oppressed humanity. 

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

'Economic Rehabilitation' of 'Differently Abled'

It is a matter of great grief, that most of the destitute, disabled specially polio affected destitute (by birth) are generally from poor financial background. Due to poverty, they are deprived of proper treatment and proper care. on one hand and on the other, have become a burden for their families, due to their disability. This is the reason, for which, they are disgraced, neglected and scolded every now and then. It becomes a cumbersome job for them, to fulfill even their daily needs and due to their poor financial condition, their life becomes a recurrence of sufferings and sedimentary. With a view to provide economical self dependency to these disabled people, 'free of Cost' Vocational Training Centers are being conducted by the Organisation, where various 'Free of Cost' programmes relating to Computer training, Electronic equipment repairing, Hardware and Networking, Home appliances repairing, Sewing training, Mobile repairing etc are being conducted.


